Home First Conventional

Key Facts for Permanent Buydowns!

- Maximum buydown not to exceed 2 points.
- <u>Buydown cannot come from DPA funds!</u> DPA loans do not offer rate buydown options!
- Points are to be calculated off the base loan amount.
- Lenders must account for points on LE & CD.
- All program rules and requirements remain the same.
- Lenders are required to issue Form 1098 to report all points paid.
